

## Pre-AP Arts: Facilitating Risk-Taking, Inventiveness, and Experimentation

### Overview:

In this workshop, participants will explore the ways in which they can help students take risks and experiment as part of their artistic process. The focus of the workshop will be on the idea that students who take risks and experiment with their artistic choices will become more adept at building skills in their disciplines. Participants will join in a Pre-AP Arts model lesson, examine a model lesson in other arts disciplines, and design their own lessons that meet the needs of their learners.

### Outcomes:

- Explore Pre-AP shared principles, Arts areas of focus, and model lessons emphasizing risk-taking and experimentation.
- Apply Pre-AP instructional routines to one's own classroom to enhance student readiness.
